1	10-8-1-4	#10 Senator Shazoom has the experience edge and top speed numbers in the opener. #8 Louisiana Aybe is a first-time starter by The Louisiana Cartel. Give her a look in the post parade.
2	2-6-8-3	#2 Fish Head has two wins this meet; should be prominent in the first of the Little Miss Roxie trials. #6 Rockys Candy Shop was a game third in the SSA Service Auction Futurity at Indiana Grand.
3	7-5-9-1	Two solid efforts for #7 Cartels Ballerina ; lots of upside for this filly from the Eggleston barn. #5 Sixes Loaded to Fly ran third in the rich Gordon Mobley Futurity; very talented juvenile!
4	6-7-8-3	#6 Apollitical Regard goes for her third win of the meet. Daughter of top sire, Apollitical Jess, has been impressive. #7 Just Like Sarah , by the same sire, is lightly raced, but speedy too.
5	1-8-4-9	Don't miss this trial as #1 Stone Cold Leader , winner of two futurities this meet, and five in a row, is just plain amazing! #8 Dna Bells Bay never misses a check; include in exotic wagers.
6	4-8-5-7	#4 All American Ease will race as a first-time gelding (FTG). Could improve focus for this well-bred 2-year-old. #8 Bs Special is a Canterbury Park stakes winner who debuts at Indiana Grand.
7	6-9-4-8	Remington Park Futurity champion #6 La Vencedora , is the ninth-ranked 2-year-old on the National AQHA Poll. #9 Sr Shambles , was brilliant in the Heartland Futurity; four wins already in 2017.
8	4-6-5-3	#4 Tommy The Train scored a huge win in the QHRAI Derby on July 8. Give #6 Fast Prize Shonda another chance. Spit Curl Jess filly was bumped hard in her debut; improvement very possible.
9	5-6-3-2	Another Oklahoma champion #5 Dicecapades should be tough in this trial. #6 Cartels Justice prepped for this with a win here on September 26; Randy Smith trainee should be rolling late.
